

Base and Mound Distances

CHLL:

- **AA pitch** at 41 feet. Norfolk only has one pitching rubber and one set of base pegs.
- **11U/12U** pitch at 46 feet and the bases are at 60 feet. At Walker, it's the closest base pegs (of three) and the closest pitching rubber. (Please note there is sometimes a third pitching rubber that is temporary for AA games in which case 46 feet would be the middle rubber). At Prospect, it is the closest base pegs and the furthest back pitching rubber.
- **Juniors** start the season pitching at 55 feet and bases are 80 feet. They move to 60'6" and 90 feet bases midway through the season.

Typical Travel Distances:

- 9U Travel pitches at the 11U/12U distance (46 feet) and uses the closest base pegs at both fields (60 feet).
- 10U Travel pitches at the 11U/12U rubber (46 feet) and uses the middle base pegs at Walker and furthest base pegs at Prospect (65 feet).
- 11/12U Travel pitches at the furthest pitching rubber at Walker (48 feet at Walker) and uses the furthest base pegs (70 feet).

Norfolk Field:

Pitching Rubber: 41 Feet (machine anchored just beyond 41)

Walker Field:

Bases: 60, 65 and 70 Feet

Pitching rubber: 46 and 48

Prospect Field:

Bases: 60 and 65 Feet

Pitching rubber: 46 and 41 Feet

Eccles Field:

Bases: 70, 80, 90 Feet

Pitching rubber: 50, 55, 60'6"
