### **Divisions for the 2023 Season:**

- 1.) **CHLL Intro to Softball (T-ball)** is for Grades Pre-K & K (approx. ages 5 & 6)
- 2.) **CHLL Coach Pitch** is for 1<sup>st</sup> Grade (approx. ages 6&7)

**Starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade all levels will form teams through a draft process, not by school or friend requests:**

- 3.) **CHLL Machine Pitch Softball** is for Grades 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> (approx. ages 7 - 8)
- 4.) **CHLL Minors Player Pitch Softball** is for Grades 4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> (approx. ages 9 - 11) 11-inch softball
- 5.) **CHLL Majors Player Pitch Softball** is for Grades 5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> (approx. Ages 10 - 12) 12-inch softball

We will work with families to determine the best fit for your child.
