Game Day Field Responsibilities

Responsibilities of each team/coach are as follows:

Both teams **MUST**:

- Assign one coach or team parent as being in charge of these duties for the season.
- If it rains prior to your game, we ask that you plan to arrive 30-60 minutes before game time to prep the field for play.
- Pick up all trash in/around the dugout after each game.

VISITOR: 1st Base dugout, BASES, SCOREBOARDS

- 30 minutes before the game, be sure bases are placed in the pegs at the appropriate distance.
- Set up the scoreboard and recruit a fan to run it during the game (Walker and Prospect Fields).
- If you don't see a team waiting to get on the field when your game has ended, make sure the scoreboard controls are stored away and the equipment box is locked. The controls are expensive!

HOME: 3rd Base dugout, PACK MOUND, RESULTS

- If you are the last game of the day on that field, “rebuild” the pitcher’s mound and batter’s box: take a shovelful of clay/dirt from the box (located down the 3B line) and fill the holes created by the players’ spikes. Tamp it down and add water to pack it tightly (leftover water bottles from the dugout are a great source).
- After the game, please email score, pitch counts, and homeruns hit to CHLL Scorekeeper at jfr14@comcast.net and copy the opposing Manager.
